Surgical Castration Pre-Surgery Instructions

To prepare your horse for his castration surgery, please review the following.

- Do not feed your horse for 6 hours prior to surgery
- Do not give your horse any water for 1 hour prior to surgery
- Our castrations are done laying down in the stall, so please have the stall prepared with clean straw for the castration.
- Prepare a clean dry area for your horse to recover from surgery. A stall with straw bedding is ideal. This will help keep the incision clean.
